English

This half-term, children will be exploring a fantasy text, Black Dog by Levi Pinfold. In English lessons, children will be reading the book Black Dog and identifying the structure of the text. They will be looking at the issue of the size of the dog and how it relates to fear and worry. This term, the main outcome will be children writing their own story with suspense based on a fear using the structure of the Black Dog. This will allow opportunities to embed speech, and adverbials for how, where and when, which they will apply within their own writing.

Curriculum link: PSHE- Is it always safe to face our fears? And should we ever judge a book by its cover?

PE: Every Tuesday

In PE this half-term, children will concentrate on developing good running, jumping and throwing techniques through athletic activities.

Art

The children will be looking at:

- Aboriginal art, in particular symbols used for words
- Creating their own aboriginal art on a journey such as their journey to school.

Mathematics

This half-term, children will be learning a range of different topic in Maths. This half-term we will be learning about:

History

We will be looking at: Romans- Invaders and Settlers.

Children will be able to identify Romans on a history timeline. They will explore how and why the Romans invaded Britain.
