Rapunzel is locked in her tower with only her Mother (The Witch) for company. She longs to see other people.

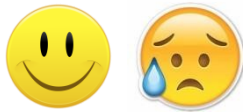
Draw a picture of who you are at home with and who you look forward to seeing soon.

Write words and sentences to explain your pictures

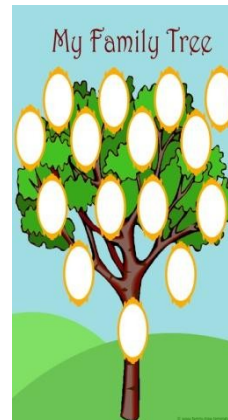


Challenge 3: How do you feel?
