# Year 5 & 6 Autumn 1 - 2020

### Mathematics

We will focus on number skills in particular place value and the four operations. By the end of the half term Year 5 and 6 will be able to:

- Compare and order numbers up to a million and year 6 will compare further up to 10 million
- Revise reading and writing roman numerals up 1000
- Rounding to the nearest 100,000 and year 6 will be extended to round up to the nearest million.
- Completing the four operations and solving multi-step problems.

## **PSHE**

This term, Year 5 and 6 will be covering the Emotions unit. We will be using role play and many different scenarios to uncover a range of emotions which in sha Allah will help everyone to share.

#### Science

We will be investigating evolution and inheritance this half term; looking at how our traits and genes are carried down to each generation and how new ones are formed due to different factors that have influenced change, which will give us a better understanding of how incredible Allah creations are.
