### **SEQUENCING AND ORDERING**

This week your child is going to be learning about how to put things in the correct order or sequence.

Talk with your child about what ordering is, give them an example then ask them to do the same.

Maybe have them put these numbers in the correct order.

### 1 4 2 3 5 8 6 9 7 10

Have your child imagine they are going to school. Talk with them about the routine they would do in the morning to get ready for school. Have them explain the steps they would take to get ready, encourage them to use sequencing words first, next, then and after.



## Ordering objects from biggest to smallest.

Have your child look at the picture, are they able to tell you which teddy is the biggest and which is the smallest? Ask them to then sort all the teddies from biggest to smallest? Ask your child to get some objects or toys from around the house and ask them to order them from biggest to smallest and then in reverse from smallest to biggest.




#### Thursday 21st January 2021
