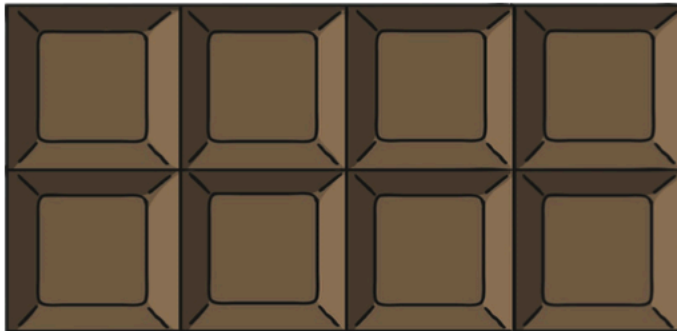
Andy has 7 football cards. His friend Tom has 3 cards. How many cards do they have altogether?
