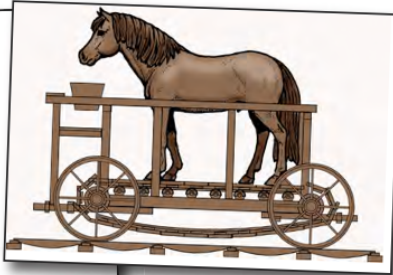

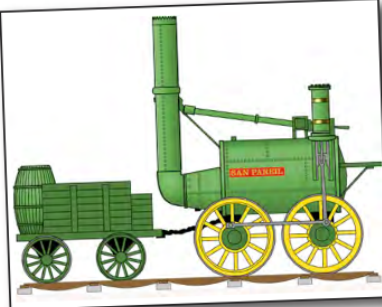
George Stephenson's Rocket

When the railway was first built between Liverpool and Manchester a contest was held to see which was the best engine for pulling the carriages and trucks along the track.

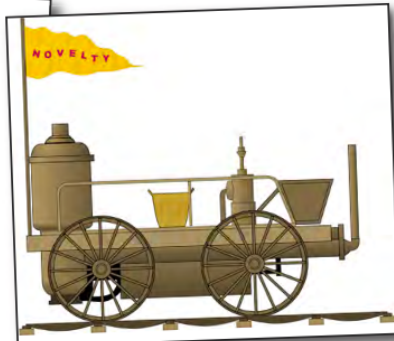

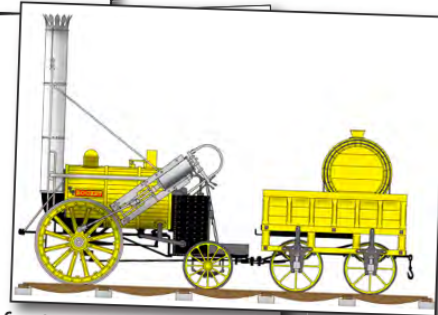
