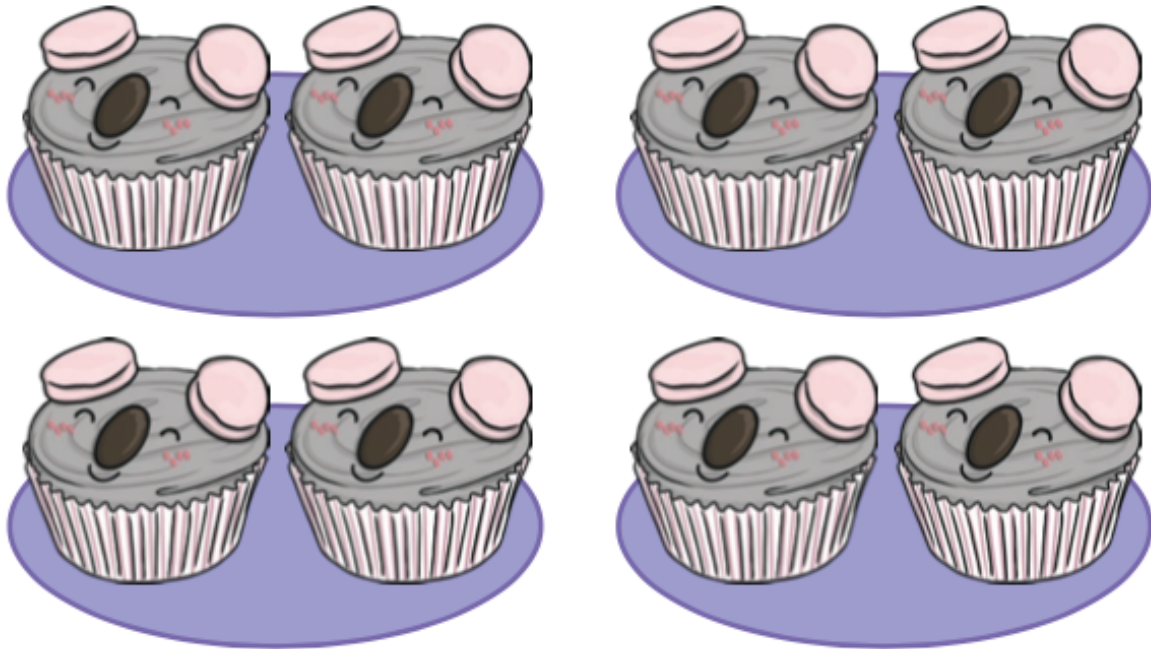
Our word of the week is **whimper**

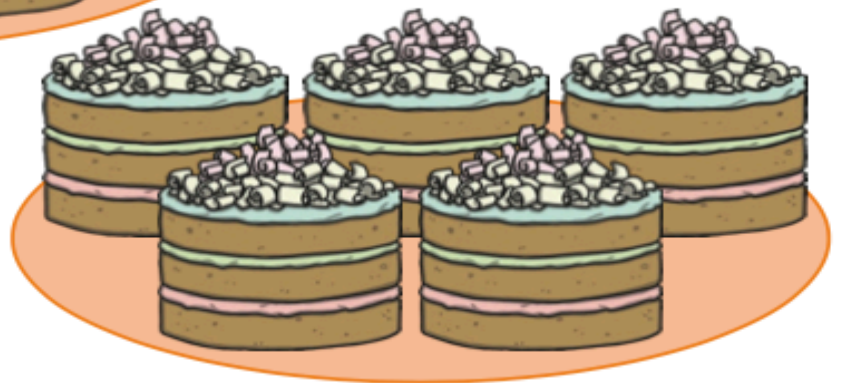
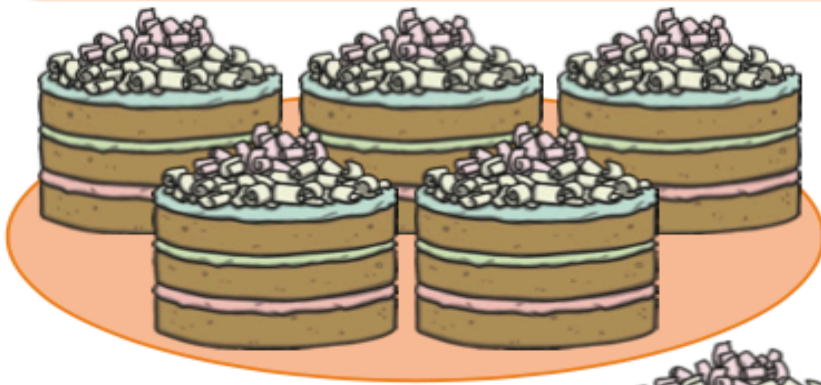

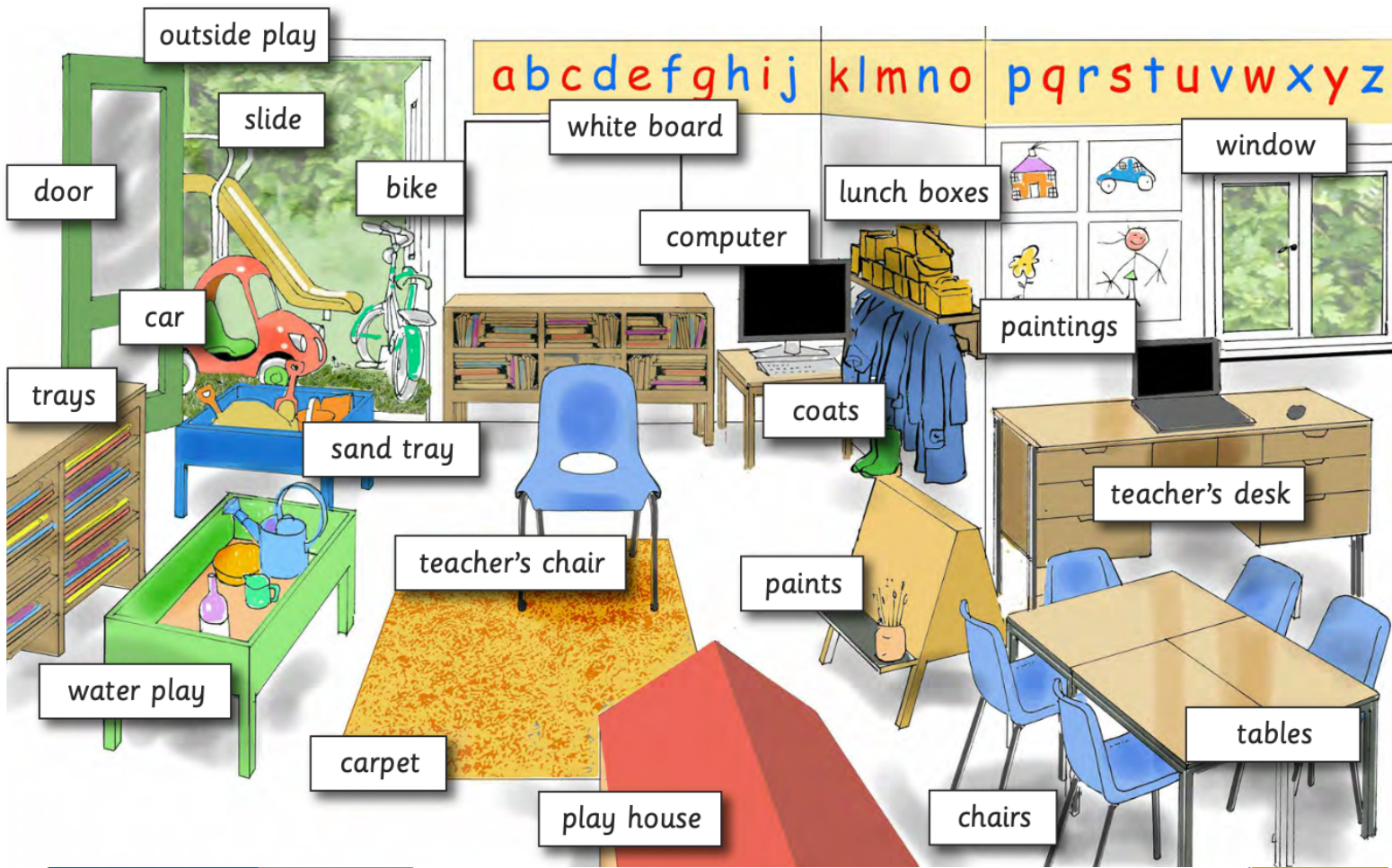
