We would like you to find out what whimper means and write down the definition.

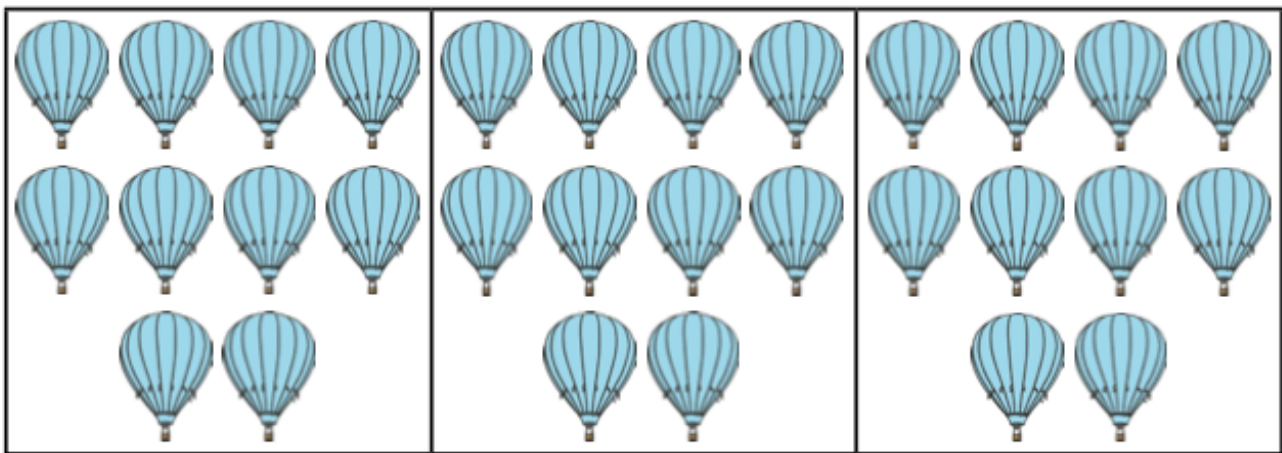

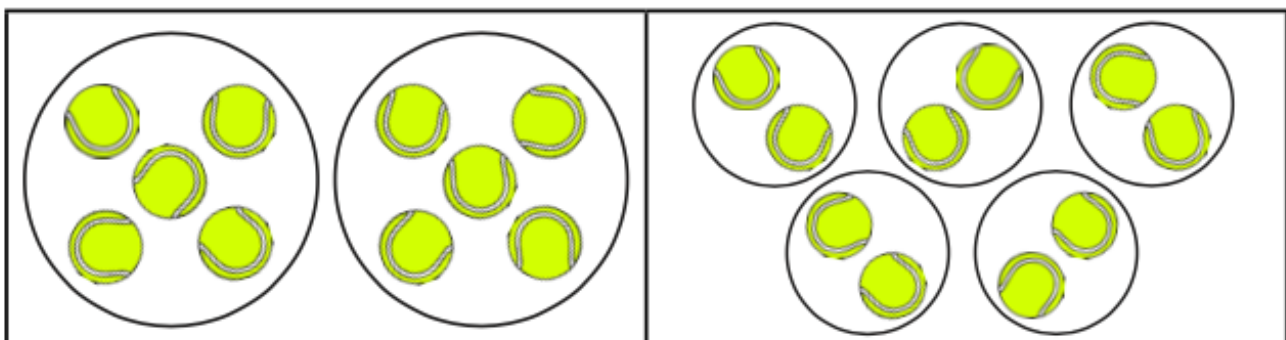

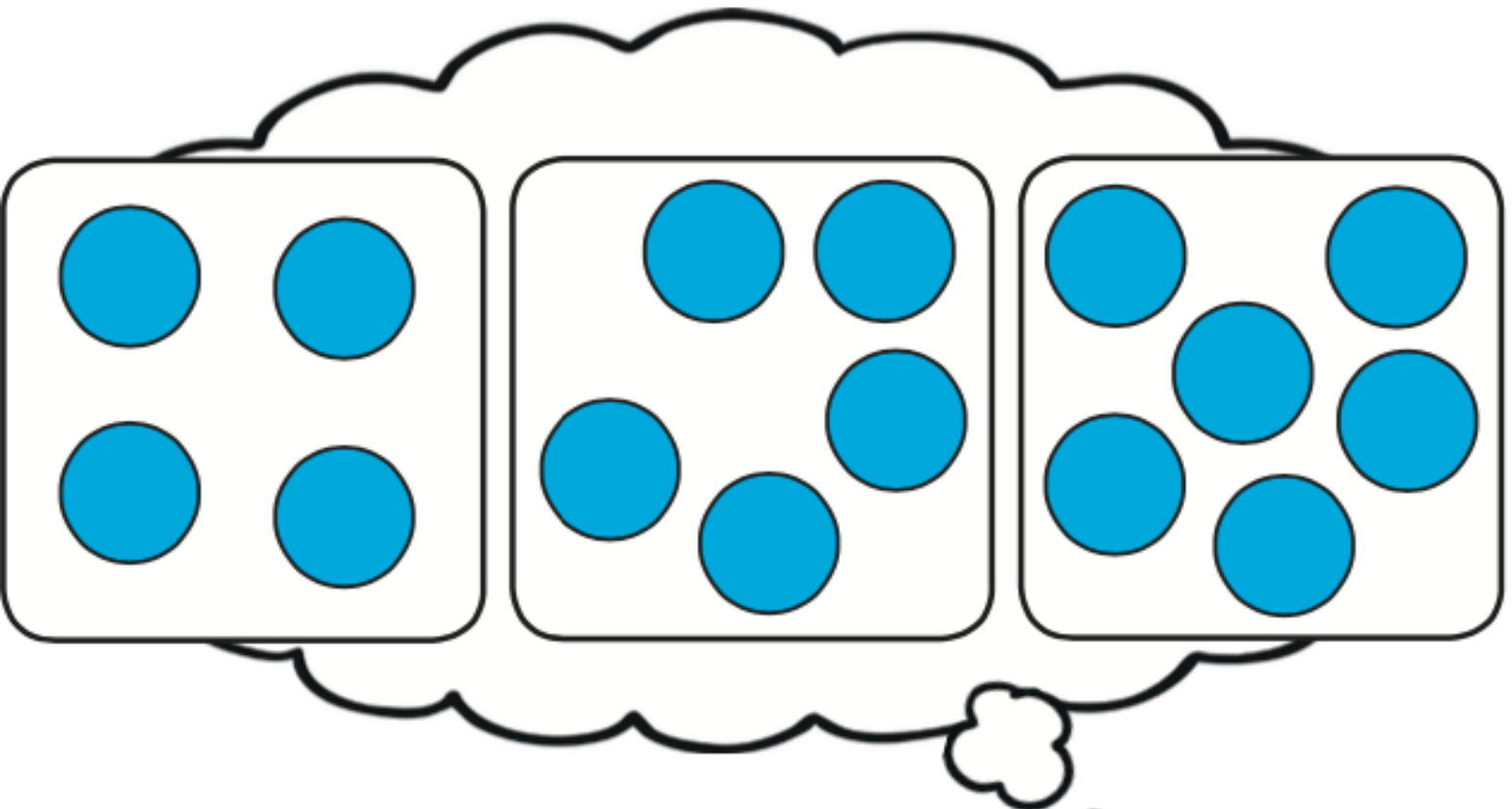

The Wright Brothers' First Flight

Wilbur and Orville Wright were brothers. They lived in America. They both liked to know how things worked. They made bicycles and sold them from their shop.

In 1900 they wanted to make a machine that could fly. First they made kites and practised flying them on a string. Then they made a glider big enough to carry a person. They flew this like a giant kite carrying a bag of sand. Wilbur lay on the bottom wing for one of the flights.



In 1901 they built a glider with larger wings but found it very difficult to control. Following this, they made lots of models with different shaped wings and tested them at home.

In 1902 they built a glider with long thin wings and a moveable rudder. They glided many times, managing to keep in the air for 26 seconds and fly 189 metres.

In 1903 they built a glider fitted with an engine and a propeller. They called it Flyer 1. In December Orville took off and flew for 12 seconds. He had made the first powered flight, controlled by a man.
