We are continuing with our next five sounds in Phase 3. Every day there will be a new sound, a video link and an activity.

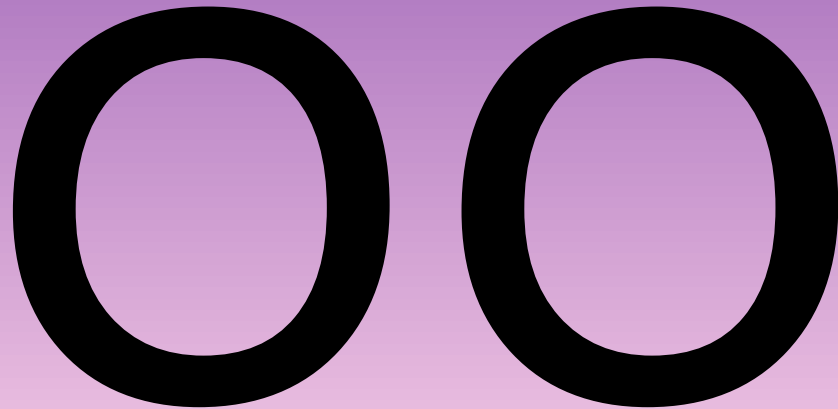
Please remember to email Ms Ruksana or Ms Abeita pictures of you watching phonics videos and doing activities in your books.
